



COVID19 Safety Precautions for In-Clinic Treatment

Please know we are taking all of the necessary and recommended precautions to keep our staff and clients safe. Please feel free to request a copy of our 9-page WorkSafeBC Safety Plan.

- ✓ We are asking all clients to call the clinic upon arrival and someone will come out to let you in
- ✓ Clients have the choice to attend appointments in-clinic or may opt for a “virtual\video session” from home
- ✓ Clients will be asked to complete the COVID19 Screening Questionnaire posted on the door prior to entering. If a client answers YES to any of the questions, their appointment will be re-scheduled
- ✓ We are limiting the number of individuals in the reception area, you may be asked to wait outside or in your car
- ✓ Waiting room chairs are spaced for physical distancing
- ✓ All Physiotherapy clients must wear a mask- their own, or one will be provided for them
- ✓ All Physiotherapy clients must wash or sanitize their hands upon entering\exiting the facility
- ✓ The treating Physiotherapist will wear a surgical grade mask, as well as a gown and eye protection when appropriate
- ✓ The treating Physiotherapist will wash their hands before and after each treatment
- ✓ Rooms (bed, chairs, equipment) will be sanitized in between each client
